What is an EDUCATION SPLOST (ESPLOST)?

ESPLOST is the option for a local school system to call a referendum approving a one percent sales tax for school facilities and/or retire bond debt. The penny sales tax spreads the responsibility of educating our children to all citizens and visitors of the community. ESPLOST is paid by anyone who makes a purchase here, including many people who do not live in our community.



What can ESPLOST funds provide for our students?

- Purchase & upgrade instructional and administrative technology
- Acquire safety and security equipment
- Acquire textbooks and other electronic educational resources
- Purchase school buses, system vehicles, transportation and maintenance equipment
- Purchase vocational, music, physical education, & athletic equipment

FACTS ABOUT CONTINUING THE 1¢ EDUCATION SALES TAX ON NOVEMBER 5, 2019





- ESPLOST is an extension of the current sales tax, not an additional tax
- The renewal of ESPLOST would start after the current Education Sales Tax ends
- Sales tax is paid by everyone who shops in Clinch County, including visitors
- These funds provide modern, safe, and secure school facilities for all children in Clinch County schools.
- Quality schools promote a better future for our students and economic growth for our community

IS THIS A TAX INCREASE?

NO! Clinch County sales tax will remain at its current level. The referendum will simply extend the current 1% sales tax for education for an additional 2 years. Collection of this renewal ESPLOST can only begin after the current ESPLOST expires.

HAVE PREVIOUS ESPLOSTS BEEN SUCCESSFUL?

YES!! The Clinch County Board of Education has a creditable record of keeping promises. There have been many facility and equipment improvements using the funds provided by the education sales tax.

WHAT are ADVANTAGES of ESPLOST?

The ESPLOST shares the cost of educational facilities and equipment with visitors and all citizens – not just property owners. Sales tax offsets property tax and helps keep property taxes stable.
